1a. MSD with 'nqathala,' the person who gets food for the initates. He is the little boy on the left. On the right is MSD's sister's little boy. The picture is taken in the bush near the boma. A boma is the house where we are living in (during initation). 'Khankatha' built the house – he is the person who is watching us and healing us. Siphiwe was the 'khankatha.' He is a member of MSD's family. He is about 25 years old. He watches over healing us.

1b. MSD in the river. Where we wash ourselves. In the morning about 5 o'clock.

2a. MSD 'standing with my stick' covering my body with a 'ingceke' – a liquid. You are crushing a stone in the water to cover your body so that nobody can identify you, even if someone who is a witch is coming to bewitch you they won't be able to see you. Stay covered for the whole process when you are there.

2b. (1 – r) MSD and Mtetho [(seated) Miss Gay Queenstown, 2000] with Siphiwe at the river.

3a. The day that the initates go home. The people are singing, happy that we are alright. The man at the front is an old man.

3b. 'Saluka' – another one who came later to join the initial initiates. With his dog. His house is in the background. He had his own house. MSD and Mthetho shared a house.

4a. MSD talking with my friend. Standing with Simpiwe. Friend's cell phone. Friends came to visit.

4b. Lubabalo (c/f 3b) playing in the river.

5a. MSD sitting with dog.

5b. MSD sitting on the stone in the river.

6a. MSD and friend Sipho who is also a gay and he was circumsized a long time ago. He is having permission to come and visit us. Because he is a man. He is a man in tradition. If you are not circumsized you have no permission to visit.

6b. MSD swimming in the river. Washing the 'ingceki.' Wash daily and reapply. 'In the afternoon, before you are sleeping, you should wash and reapply.' His river is too deep. In the middle of it.

7a. 'Me enjoying myself'

7b. At school doing Std 8

7c. My former boyfriend. First boyfriend. 16 years old. Still at school. He was 32 years old. Broke up last year. MSD is 24 years old. Found out he is married. He cheated to me with another man. He had an affair with my friend. Married with three children.

Few girls in Queenstown. Lots of boys. Means that we are in the risk of having HIV if you are not condomised, because they are mixing us with girls they are living a double life. They are very interested in us, but we are few.

There are six girls in Queenstown. Half of the community do it after nine. Some of them are the professionals. Teachers, doctors, some big names. They are lying to us. They didn't told us they are having someone. Even each and everyone wants to have us, maybe three of us or four of us. They don't want us to tell our friends about that – if you are involved.
