

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

.K. ladies listen up! Since the new year is upon us I want to ask you all again to keep a few things in mind. First of all, it is time to change the copy and photos in your personal ad. Remember to sign the back of the photos giving Pathway permission to print. When you send in your ad it is a good idea to ask the person responding to be sure to send a photo and a self addressed stamped envelope (SASE). Be honest and sincere about who you are and what type of people you want to meet and describing yourself and interests. I have met so many wonderful friends this way and you can too. I always respond and tell the party that I do not make house calls. Another thing that one must stay away from is meeting a stranger at a motel or hotel room alone. There is a section on page 32 that is called Category Crisis and I want each and everyone of you to have the opportunity to read it. I am going to copy the section and make it basically this month's column. When you finish I will have details on how you can order this wonderful book. One that our community has needed for quite sometime.

gist and homosexual rights activist Magnus Hirschfield (1868-1935) in the early part of the twentieth century. Hirschfeld observed in Die Transvestism, on the basis of his own research among (and friendship with) hundreds of cross-dressers, that transvestism was not in itself a sign of underlying homosexuality and in fact occurred most frequently in heterosexuals. Hirschfeld saw a relationship between androgynes and transvestites; where androgynes were concerned with the physical marks of gender (beard, breasts, genitals), transvestites concerned themselves instead with psychical or psychological gender signs, like dress and names. Male transvestites, he thought, were resistant to being called or thought of as homosexuals, and hated "sissies"; female transvestites were more likely to be homosexual, although some fell in love with feminine men. But he

argued strongly that transvestism was a "thing in itself," quite distinct from sexual orientation.9

In later years researchers and clinicians have tended to reconfirm this judgment, even as they acknowledge a broad spectrum of cross-dressing behaviors from transvestophilia (or transvestic fetishism) to transsexualism to the non-fetishistic cross-dressing that is commonly known as transvestism. Richard F. Docter identifies "five heterosexual behavior patterns involving cross dressing: fetishism, fetishistic transvestism, marginal transvestism, transgenderism, and secondary transsexualism (TV type)" and four homosexual behavior patterns involving cross-dressing: primary transsexualism, secondary transsexualism, so called drag queens, and female impersonators."10 In Docter's terms, "drag queens" are cross-dressed prostitutes, including "she-males" (men who wear flamboyantly feminine costumes, makeup, and hair-

styles while they signal an unmistakably male body beneath their female clothes), while "female impersonators" are professional entertainers. The term "female impersonator" at the turn of the century also meant male homosexual crossdresser, while "drag queen" does not by any means always connote prostitution in general slang usage, but itself sometimes crosses over into entertainment or recreational selfdisplay.11 As this multiplication of categories and shifting of connotations indicates, slippage and confusion seem to he constitutive rather than accidental features of the attempt to define transvestism.

"Transvestism alone," gender researcher John Money stresses, "is not a syndrome of cross dressing. Instead it is a manifestation of the act of cross dressing. Since dressing is traditionally gender-coded almost everywhere on earth, cross dressing is one highly specific act of gender crosscoding" (emphasis added).12

One source of confusion over the relation between transvestism and homosexuality has to do with the difference between gender construction and sexual attraction. In response to an inquiry about whether male cross-dressers could be "lesbians trapped in male bodies," a male sex educator and counselor who was himself a cross-dresser testified on the Geraldo show in February 1989 to the "confusion that the public has between sex role preference and expression, and gender-role preference, The term "transvestite" was invented by the German sexolo- 6 which is what we see here" (Geraldo, 10-11). The question,



offered as an earnest attempt to understand, came from someone who confessed having "a difficult time classifying these men as heterosexual men," despite their evident attraction to-and in some cases marriage to-women. One of the married cross-dressers explained, kindly, that "You're confused about the reason we dress. We're not dressing for a sexual reason, to attract anyone. We're expressing a femininity that we have within" (Geraldo, 10).

This "confusion," of gender versus sex or sexuality, is in fact one of the key misunderstandings that has produced the issue under debate. But, as we will see, the distinction is not always an easy one to make; the borderline between gender and sexuality so important to much recent feminist and gender theory is one of the many boundaries tested and queried by the transvestite. The cultural effect of transvestism is to destabilize all such binaries: not only "male" and "female," but also "gay" and "straight," and "sex" and "gender." This is the sense-the radical sense-in which transvestism is a "third."

At the close of his program on married cross-dressers, Phil Donahue offered the television audience the address of an organization called Tri-Ess, the initials of which stand for "Society for the Second Self." Tri-Ess, which is sometimes described as a "sorority" and calls its cross-dressed members "sisters," has been at the center of a controversy among cross-dressers that again underscores the tensions around transvestism and gay identity, because Tri-Ess restricts its membership to heterosexual, male crossdressers. In a published debate in a journal called *Gender Expressions*, Eileen McCleary, a Tri-Ess member, and Joann Roberts, a founder of the Renaissance Educational Association and the author of a book called *Art and Illusion-A Guide for Crossdressers*, disputed the merits of Tri-Ess's exclusionary policy.

Roberts accused Tri-Ess of discrimination and homophobia, reading the Tri-Ess claim of offering a "comfortable environment" for cross-dressers as a confirmation of "the homophobic nature of their closed membership policy," and dismissing as "machismo" and disrespectful of women the idea that Tri-Ess excludes gays and transsexuals because to include them would upset members' wives. "The Tri-Ess Philosophy has become the Fundamentalism of the crossdressing community," she concludes. "Why are they so afraid to admit gay TVs? Because they know that almost all crossdressing has erotic, sexual roots and that the 'hobby' line is only a ploy to defuse the issue with the general public. If they are seen to associate with gay TVs, then somehow that is an admission that transvestism is sexual."13 The question was also raised as to whether cross-dressing groups did, or should, serve as dating agencies for members; some wives apparently fear that if gays were admitted, their husbands might take up new relationships that excluded them. This fear again speaks to the ambivalence about the gay/TV axis, even among sympathetic spouses.

The alternative to Tri-Ess is the "open" group, and in many cities such groups exist side-by-side with "closed" (male hetero) gender societies. McCleary argued that choice within cross-dressing lifestyles as well as the choice to cross-dress was essential for the community, and cited some statistics from a national TV-TS journal to support the fact that sexual orientation is in fact on the minds of cross-dressers when they identify themselves as such. (For example, she reports that 19% of those placing personals ads noted that they were members of Tri-Ess, while an additional 16% described themselves as "hetero.") The personals ad, which solicits companionship and-often-sex, 7

seems a loaded indicator for determining whether cross-dressing and gay and lesbian lifestyles coincide, but what is quite clear from both the Tri-Ess controversy and even fragmentary data like these is that the *question* of such an overlap is very much on the minds of crossdressers, as of the general public.

A male transvestite's cross-gender identity as a "woman," or a female transvestite's identity as a "man," is not, or not always. what some psychologsts call a "core gender identity," for the word "core" here insists on a ground, an identifiable "real" gender identity, rather than on the complex interplay, slippage. and parodic recontextualization of gender markers and gender categories that characterize transvestic fantasy. The transsexual may wish to literalize that fantasy through an alteration in the body; the transvestite keeps the fantasy in play, though often in a ritualized way, by deploying a rhetoric of clothing, naming, and performance or acting out. This is not at all the same as saying that transvestism is a game, an act, or a wholly discretionary, optional, and playful set of behaviors. Quite to the contrary, it is, for many transvestites, both a profoundly serious and also a lonely business-as can he seen in both the personals ads and the self-help journals of the TV community today, and in the landmark fiction of the early years of this century, where sexual and sartorial borderlines were increasingly explored and crossed.

The book is one I have not been able to put down. On the back are a few comments by book reviewers. "A fascinating compendium of cross-dressing.... and a provocative piece of cultural criticism", New York Times. "An extraordinary rich study which will redefine current debates about the construction of sex and gender. It is also a funny, moving, and powerful. Anyone interested in sexual difference-and who is not, will want to read Vested Interests", Women's Review Of Box. One more and I will give details on how to order this book. my friend Sloane and she mentioned she had a nice full length sequined number that she was selling. When I checked my funds, I realized I could not afford the dress so I traded her a pair of high heels. It was then I realized that I would be wearing a dress that many have seen me in before on stage. At first I had a funny feeling about this as I have always made a point of telling ladies it is important to find a new dress or look. The money that had been in my party fund for my new dress was not there. A few weeks earlier Nina Charese called me to ask me what I planned to do for the models in the fashion show? I meant it because I felt it was the proper thing to do and I loved every minute that evening.

Silly to some, but to me, it has always been important to dress one's best at a dinner at say Moonlight in Manhattan or a fetish party in Orange County. Looking back I am happy that without a beat I put the money in those envelopes. Coming out to me has meant finding new friends that mean a whole lot to me. Should anyone ask why I wore my "cold shoulder" Donna Karan knock off, I will tell them that there are many reasons and since it is a long story. I will see that they hear it someday.

I just want to mention that for sometime now I have been writing this column. Many of you readers have mentioned to me that you do enjoy it. Thank you for your kind words and they do mean so very much. We all have so very much in common and our community is the biggest support group in the world. We are all in this together and we all are constantly putting on those high heels and dealing with coming out.






o Wong Foo, many thanks to you for being the inspiration for a movie that has done many positive things for the gender community. As for Julie Newmar, she has been busy trekking around Southern California and across the country. Doing PR for the movie that carries her name. Last week she was at the Virgin Records Megastore on Sunset Blvd. She was signing autographs and acting as Mistress of Ceremonies for a "Drag Contest." Drag is more than in right now. Drag is hot and the receipts at the box office prove it. The bottom line is what sells and men "en-femme", in movies, and talk shows are making profits for all concerned.

When the hit movie from England called, "The Crying Game" starring the ambiguous and androgynous Jaye Davidson made millions at the box office. The writing was on the wall and the scriptwriters were all alone cranking outnew "drag" stories. Before this the history of drag in film was a very poor one. ost people think when you are talking about transgendered people that you are talking about the male to female crossdresser or transsexual. August 17-20, I went to San Francisco to attend a conference for female to male transsexuals. I have been to alot of conferences around the country and have seen a few female to male transsexuals but this was the first time I had ever attended a conference that was dedicated to cover the female to male transsexual issues.

Two years ago when the idea was first conceived the vision was that they would probably get 75 to 100 people. The beginning came about when AEGIS and IFGE donated seed money to help get the idea started and with the hard work of James Green and many other people from the female to male community they put together a conference that went over very well.

I have had a lot of questions from people wondering why male to female crossdresser would want to attend a female to male transsexual conference. Two years ago at a IFGE convention in Portland I attended a female to male committee meeting to work with them trying to come up with ideas on how IFGE can market an Out Reach to the female to male portion of the transgendered community. They were drawing up a resolution for the female to male committee. It was mentioned that it would be a good idea to have people from other segments of the community who could share information and ideas that might help them in putting together their out reach to the female to male segment of the community.

Well, knowing how involved I am in the community not only was I asked to be a member of the committee but I was nominated and elected as a co-chairperson along with James Green and Jason Cronwell.

When the resolution was read to the board and the names of the chairperson was read, there were some really funny looks. I feel that if any of us can reach out and give help to another segment of the community, that we are helping ourselves because as the female to male segment of the community grows it will be helping the over all transgendered community grow.

I was able to attend the Friday evening session and see the overwhelming success the conference was from the beginning. They thought that they might get 100 people but when I talked to James there were over 350 people registered from all segments of the community and supporting family members and friends. Friday night's crowd was very enthusiastic. The speakers were really motivated and reached out and challenged those in attendance to participate and really go home with a knowledge that they came and were able to learn how to reach out to others and help their community grow.

A lot of hard work went into making the first female to male conference a success. Many people in the San Francisco took attendees in to their homes to help lessen the cost of the conference so people who couldn't afford to stay in the hotel would be able to attend and learn and take home good information that would help them in their struggles in life as a transgendered person.

It was exciting to see and talk to the different people who attended. Because of the overwhelming response they had to move the Friday evening session to the "San Francisco Women's Club" to have seating for everyone who had registered. After the session they hosted free food and drinks for all in attendance. They put away all the chairs and a DJ came in and set up their equipment for music to dance to or just socialize with those in attendance.

The conference ran Friday thru Sunday. With a packed schedule, I felt it was real important to take the time and come up and attend what I could of the conference being a board member for AEGIS and IFGE who had given seed money to help to make this conference happen. Because of the work commitment I wasn'table to get a lot of the day time meetings but in talking to some of the other participants they had nothing but good things to say about the conference.

Being up in San Francisco I needed a place to stay so I was invited by Dehania to come stay at her place in Richmond. It was about a 45 minute drive but I really had a great time and it gave me a chance to visit with friends and do something that I had always fantasized about but never thought I would ever do: that was to go out by the Golden Gate Bridge and take pictures. So Saturday afternoon after work I got dressed up and we jumped in the car and went to the San Francisco ferry terminal and took a few pictures

and then onto the Golden Gate Bridge. The lighting was beautiful, we shot three roles of film. Dehania is a professional photographer and she really made me work. We wandered around to different areas around the bridge and shot pictures. Some of the tourists were wondering what was going on, it was lots of fun. We had a few shots left on the last role so on our way back to Richmond we stopped at the San Quientin State Prison sign and shot up the remaining shots. I didn't think much about it at the time but later we were talking about it and I was telling some of my friends how I got a number of letters from guys in prison and they want me to come visit them dressed. I have turned them down, as I have heard some of the horror stories that transgendered people have gone through when they visited a friend in prison. I told my friends that I hoped that sign was the closest I ever get to any prison.

Saturday night we went out to check out the local night life and get something to eat. Several of the bars in San Francisco were hosting special happy hours for people who attended the conference. We checked out a few of the bars and headed back to the house so I could get some sleep to go to work Sunday morning.

After work Sunday, I came back to the house and Toni had come over and barbecued up ribs, chicken and hot links so we sat around and talked and enjoyed good food until it was time for me to go.

It was a good trip. The female to male conference was a big success and I was able to do some things I had just dreamed about doing, and spending time with good friends. This is what life is all about. Expressing your feelings and doing things to fulfill those special needs in your life.

Once arriving at her favorite Bistro she becomes keenly aware that the diners are clocking her before she even enters the lobby. What gives?

I couldn't possibly be the black patentleather platform Mary-Janes with the white thigh-hi stockings and her oh-soparochial plaid jumper mini, now could it? But how could this be? Naomi Campbell was posing in this pricey little number on the cover of Vogue just a few months earlier. "The look" was the talk of couture on Fashion Television last season. Why then, why?

Meanwhile our now humiliated gal skulks out of the entrance and heads back home for dinner-for-one a la Dominos. Yes people, what we have here is a fugitive from the fashion police.

Now you don't have to be a crossdresser to be a fashion victim. Internationally the women of the world have had it up to their brow line with the convoluting face of fashion during the past two years. Hem-lines mutate from 1 1/2 inches above the knee to 1 1/2 inches below the crotch down to 1 1/2

inches from the start of the calf. Glossy to matted to metallic. Shoes lose their backs then crawl up the leg, then get chunky and stacked. Even the hip "retro" look proves itself evasive; 60's bell bottom hip-huggers are replaced by disco/funk synthetics from the mid-seventies and at this fleeting moment are being exchanged for late seventies cords and banded T-shirts. The majority of seasoned fashion mavens are keeping their greenbacks in their purses and the fashion industry is starting to experience a new low in sales.

If you do pursue the current trends this can especially be economic torment for the crossdresser. At least everyday women can wear the flavor-of-the-month excessively until in quickly passe. The CD might get less than a dozen wearings before she is filling out its price tag for a garage sale.

How then can we begin to be protected from designer hit & run? What follows is a TOP 10 List of ways to avoid being a fashion victim. They are merely guide-lines to keep in mind. Some might make logical sense when you read them but it seems that when in the midst of a shopping fervor, logic of times comes up a little short. These points are for the CD who wishes to add authenticity to her presentation. If you choose to go with a vampish drama-queen look, power to you, but if you are are aiming for a passing girl about town look read on.

- 1) Accessories, Accessories, Accessories: Its a small chunk of change and can add the needed piazz to whatever look you are after. A scarf alone can offer a dozen looks. Let them be your personal signature and you'll have fashion and cash to pay the bills.
- 2) If You Do It, Do It Right: If you must strive to be a fashion plate then find a designer line that works for you and stick with it. DKNY can clash badly with LIZ CLAIBORNE. The pieces are in a collection for a reason and veering outside of the line can be a disaster. Also if you must be the next "Twiggy" or "Alexis," don't do it in the bread aisle of Ralph's.
- 3) Put Your Right Foot Forward: do not ever force your tootsies into wrong-seized fashion footwear. You want a pleasant demeanor to match your finely tuned ensemble. A foot blister can ruin your day (and your sashay).
- 4) Don't Wig Out: Some people put so much effort on their clothes that they completely ignore appropriate wig care. Choose a style that frames your face as your clothes need to frame your body. The look should be contemporary but functional. Most people think that a new wig is ready to be plopped on your head but that is not true. They all need some customized styling and thinning to wearer by a professional to achieve the desired

natural look (unless you're are going to Wigstock, then tease, tease, tease, and except to trash it after the event).

5) Beware of The Clearance Sale: I know this is an undeniable temptation but resist you must. There is a reason the articles are on clearance. In 90% of all cases it is attributed to the awkwardness of the cut, unmatchable and unsightly

dye choices, details and appliqués from hell, and most dangerous of all the fact that they are already fashion cadavers. Only the most seasoned shopper can handle the rigors of a radical markdown without dismissing all of the points just mentioned.

6) Back To Basics: Any full-timer will tell you a wardrobe starts with some essentials. A jacket/ blouse/skirt combo that offers a neutral base is the nucleus (wheat, black, grey, white/off-white). Be careful of the luscious designer muted tones, unless you have the hefty budget to stay in that designer's season line, the tones otherwise can be a pain to match. 8) Own Your Body: Admit to your physique. Your height, frame and weight are all integral in finding the look that will work for you. For example a short, stocky CD will not be able to wear wide horizontal stripes unless she wants to be mistaken for a panorama of the Grand Canyon. A slight CD would, however benefit greatly from the proportions it might lend. Inversely, a vertical strip on

her would make her look "all-legs" while, on our stocky gal, they would prove thinning and elongating. The cut of a style, the pattern and size all need to complement what is a positive about your form and de-emphasize your flaws.

9) Mirrors Lie: No one likes to admit it but its true. If you try on clothes in a store your adrenaline rush will flood your

> mind with illusions of grandeur. If you try your treasures on at home you are in fantasy world central where even the most inappropriateattirewill seem legitimate. A single mirror will quite often show you what you want to see but two or more mirrors and reflections will start to paint for you a truer picture. We don't live in a one dimensional world so you need the other perspectives to help you see the real picture. That's why most girls shop together, to get the second, more rational, opinion.

10) Models Are Not Real People: Remember the majority of today's models are victims of eating dis-

orders and are starving to suit the needs of the industry that pays them. The same threads that give an ad a "come hither" waif look will not give the same impression on a 5'10", size, 13, genetic male no matter how appropriate the padding and corsetry.
