

ANNIE GETS ONE YEAR.

The Woman Known as Frank Blunt
Sentenced for Larceny.

FOND DU LAC, WIS., Jan. 5.—Annie Morris, alias Frank Blunt, the woman who has tried to be a man for the last fifteen years, was sentenced to the penitentiary for one year by Judge Gilson this morning. She was arrested several months ago in Milwaukee, charged with stealing \$175 in Fond du Lac. It was then discovered that the prisoner was a woman, although she had worn masculine attire nearly all her life. A jury convicted her of larceny and a motion for a new trial had been under advisement by Judge Gilson. This morning he overruled the motion for a new trial and sentenced the prisoner to the penitentiary. After the sentence had been passed, Gertrude Field, a woman who claimed to have married the prisoner in Eau Claire, fell upon the neck of the convict and wept for half an hour. This woman has furnished all the money for Blunt's defense and now proposes to furnish more to carry the case to the supreme court.
