There will be a memorial for Malcolm Michaels, a/k/a Marsha Johnson, on Sinatra Drive tonight, Aug. 23. Michaels' former housemate, Randy Wicker, said Marsha's ashes will be scattered in the Hudson River around 7 p.m. after a brief ceremony led by Father Bob Chabak of Sts. Peter and Paul Church.

Marsha, a longtime Hoboken resident and prominent member of the New York gay community, was found floating in the Hudson River on July 6.
