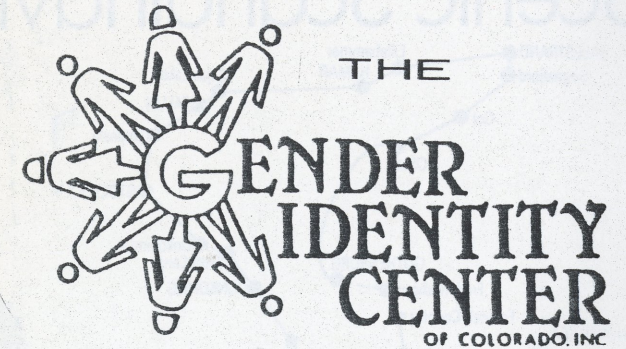

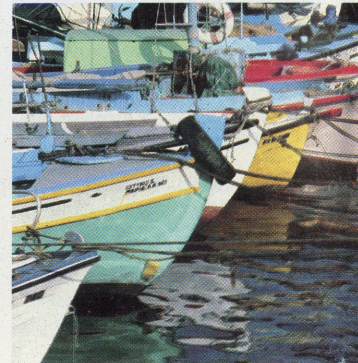
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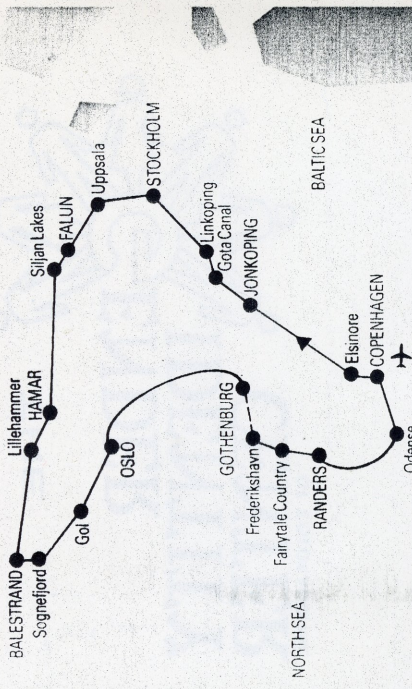

Scenic Scandinavia



Fly to the scenic wonderlands and enticing capitals of Scandinavia on this sparkling tour of Denmark, Sweden and Norway.

Never before have you experienced such natural splendor: sapphire fjords and soaring cliffs, fairy-tale villages and glittering lakes, plummeting waterfalls and crisp mountain air.

If the scenery is sublime, the service is impeccable. Enjoy the spotless first class hotels for which Scandinavia is famous. Hearty breakfasts which give every day a great start. Lavish smorgaasbord buffets. Swedish saunas. And sophisticated city nightlife.

A welcoming party in Copenhagen's glittering Tivoli Gardens, a breathtaking fjord cruise, and an elegant dinner overlooking Oslo are just some of the highlights on this refreshing holiday.

Day 1 USA - En Route Overnight flight jets across the Atlantic.

Day 2 Copenhagen, Denmark Arrival in Denmark's cosmopolitan capital is met by our Tour Director, who accompanies us to our hotel. Balance of the day free to explore this exhilarating city. Maybe window-shop along traffic-free

Stroget, then head for the waterfront cafés of the Nyhavn district. Try seafood for dinner—a Danish specialty. (Hotel: *Sheraton.*)

Day 3 Copenhagen The famed Little Mermaid, harbor area and Town Hall lead to a visit of Christiansborg Palace or Rosenborg Castle on included sightseeing. Leisure afternoon to shop in Den Permanente, a showcase of Denmark's modern design. Tonight, we're off to glittering Tivoli Gardens for a festive welcome dinner party.

Day 4 Copenhagen - Elsinore - Jönköping, Sweden This morning, we drive along the Zealand coast to Elsinore for a visit to Hamlet's imposing castle. A three-mile ferry ride across the Øresund then takes us to Sweden. Medieval castles dot a rich, fertile countryside as we cross Skåne province into Småland, Sweden's lovely lakeland. Dinner awaits us at our hotel in Jönköping, beautifully set on the southernmost tip of Lake Vattern. (Hotel: *Ramada.*)

Day 5 Jönköping - Gota Canal - Linköping - Stockholm Along the rocky shores of Lake Vattern to Granna, famous for its candy. Then we follow the Gota Canal, the enchanting inland waterway that links Gothenburg with Stockholm. Along the way there's time to admire the medieval cathedral at Linköping before we reach scintillating Stockholm. Tonight, perhaps enjoy a traditional Swedish smorgaasbord. (Hotel: *Grand.*)

Day 6 Stockholm This morning, the cobble streets and market places of the Old Town, City Hall and rococo Royal Palace are all viewed on sightseeing that's capped off by a relaxing cruise on Stockholm's canals. A leisure afternoon to enjoy this 700-year-old, up-to-date city. Explore the shops for exquisite designs of Swedish glass, stainless steel, silver and ceramics. Tonight, seek out the pleasures of Skansen, on an island in the middle of town, or Garmia Stan, the oldest part of the city.

Day 7 Stockholm - Uppsala - Falun First this morning to the ancient university city of Uppsala, cradle of Swedish civilization. Here we see the stained-glass glory of Gothic Domkyrkan cathedral, Gustav Vasa's castle and the Vikings' mysterious sacrificial burial mounds. On through thick fir forests to waterside Falun, where included dinner awaits. (Hotel: *Grand.*)

Day 8 Falun - Sijian Lakes - Hamar, Norway A delightfully scenic day as we drive past sparkling Sijian lakes and tumbling mountain streams, rugged peaks and narrow valleys into Dalarna, birthplace of Swedish independence, where traditional costumes are still worn and age-old customs kept alive. Crossing the swift-running Glomma River we enter Norway and journey through evergreen forests to Hamar, on the shores of tranquil Lake Mjosa. Dinner tonight at our hotel. (Hotel: *Victoria.*)

Day 9 Hamar - Lillehammer - Balestrand Skirting the sapphire-blue lake, we come to the sporting center of Lillehammer and Vinstra, in the heart of Ibsen's Peer Gynt country. Now a magical drive along Gudbrandsdal Valley and across Sognefjell ridge to the natural grandeur of Feigum Falls. The scenery grows even grander as we follow the magnificent Sognefjord to Balestrand. After dinner at our waterside hotel, take a stroll in this superb setting. (Hotel: *Kviknes.*)

Day 10 Balestrand - Sognefjord - Gol - Oslo A ferry across the fingers of Sognefjord, then on to Borgund church. Now through the scenic Hemsedal Valley to Gol. We pass legendary Ringerike, where Viking

sagas were born, en route to Oslo, Norway's spacious, clean capital. Tonight, there's a Norwegian dinner party with aquavit at Holmenkollen, overlooking the city. (Hotel: *SAS Scandinavia.*)

Day 11 Oslo A hearty Norwegian breakfast before we visit the Kon Tiki and Viking Ships Museums on Bygdøy peninsula. Other sights this morning include the Vigeland sculptures in 75-acre Frogner Park, City Hall and the National Theater. Balance of the day at leisure; perhaps lunch on reindeer steaks, roam Akershus Castle with its enthralling Resistance Museum or ponder paintings at Edvard Munch Museum. Tonight, maybe head for Teaterkafeen, a restaurant favored by actors and artists.

Day 12 Oslo - Gothenburg, Sweden Our road south takes us through rolling farmland back into Sweden. At Vitykke we pass ancient fortresses, prehistoric rock carvings and quaint villages, hugging the coast until we arrive in Gothenburg. An orientation drive includes Carl Milles' famed "Poseidon" fountain and the city's magnificent gardens, then to our hotel for dinner. (Hotel: *Europa.*)

Day 13 Gothenburg - Fairytale Country - Randers, Denmark Ferrying across the Kattegat to Frederikshavn, we start our drive through northern Jutland, legendary home of the Vikings. Passing Aalborg, we pause at lovely Rebild National Park, established by Danish-Americans in their ancestral homeland. Then into the heart of Fairytale Country to medieval Randers, where storks still nest in chimney tops. Enjoy included dinner at our hotel tonight. (Hotel: *Kongens Ege.*)

Day 14 Randers - Odense - Copenhagen A 13th-century cathedral—Denmark's largest—and a quaint Old Town await in Aarhus this morning. Then across Little Belt Bridge to Odense to visit Hans Christian Andersen's Museum and St. Knud's Gothic Cathedral. Now through Danish farmlands before ferrying across the Great Belt to Copenhagen. Maybe head back to Tivoli for a farewell fling. (Hotel: *Sheraton.*)

Day 15 Copenhagen - USA Homeward bound, arriving later today.
