GERRI C. (DC) Tradewinds Hostess

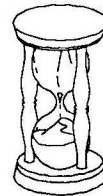
Loves trivia games, most music, and history. Former Chairperson for Delta Chi, but would rather be president of the DAR, or a Cherokee Princess.

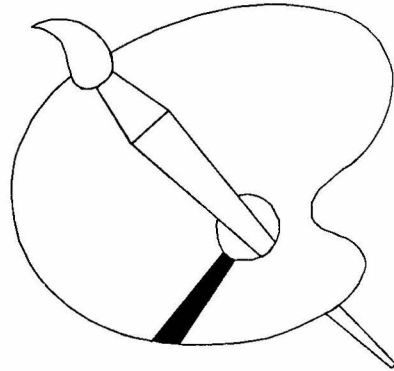

DAWN H. (CT)

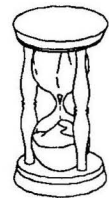

ALISON L. (PA) House Hostess at Watermark Inn

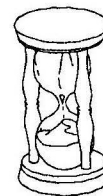
