

Male/Female Separation A Ritual Workshop

A theatrical event, recreating and ritualizing the transformation of male/female separation into the experience of internal union--the perfect androgynous state--will be a highlight of the upcoming First International World Symposium on Androgyny.

Guided by Swami Anand Veereshwar (William Pennell Rock), a lifelong student of behavioral sciences, comparative religions of East and West, and most recently, a student and workshop leader for Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh, Veereshwar will gather 20 selected participants to join him in a five-day Androgyny workshop and ritual. The workshop will lead up to the theatre of transformation presentation, "The Alchemical Play", a 1 1/2 hour performance scheduled for Saturday, June 28 at the conference.

A masterful teacher in the archetypal mystical traditions expressed both through the works of C.G. Jung as well as the ancient Upanishads of India, Veereshwar has inspired the delightful five-day workshop training, where he and his 20 "players" will romp around the famed San Diego beachside Androgyny Retreat preparing and clearing their theatrical talents, culminating in the frenzied improvisational theatre per-



formance aimed at catharsis--a total group experience of androgyny, inviting everyone at the conference to participate.

Veereshwar has called for Androgynists finest--performers, actors, dancers, and musicians, as well as anyone who likes to play, to join him beginning June 20 to Sunday evening, June 22, for an intensive weekend workshop, to be followed by daily three-hour sessions through the Saturday performance.

What is the Androgyny Center?

The Androgyny Center proposes a range of choices by which people can identify themselves, secure that the masculine/feminine interaction within each individual is not only normal, but the dynamic factor in his/her wholeness.

These energies interact within everyone, regardless of sex. Androgyny involves recognizing the eternal flux of these opposing energies within us.
