DUDLEY LIDDELL AGAIN IN HANDS OF POLICE.

Dudley Liddell, aged 16, of 1224 Termon ave., Northside, who was arrested several months ago while masquerading the police alleged as a girl in the Northside parks and following a hearing before a police magistrate was paroled, was taken into custody by Special Officer John Beck and E.
