Oxford Street (in the Lafayette Avenue Presbyterian Church). **G train** to Fulton Ave. -- walk Lafayette to So. Oxford Street. **2,3,4,5,,B,D,Q N,R trains** to Atlantic/Pacific (Hanson Place exit) -- walk 4 blocks down Hanson Place to So. Oxford. Take a left, ALP is at the end of the block, on the right.
