## ELLIS GLENN'S CASE.

## Transferred to United States Court for Hearing.

PARKERSBURG, W. Va., Jan. 30.-The peculiar case of Ellis Glenn, now on trial here for forgery, has taken a new turn, and been transferred for the time being to the United States court. Ellis Glenn is a woman who for years has been known as a man, and has not only done a man's work as carpenter, plumber, stonemason, plasterer and in other capacities, but has also made love to more than one young woman. Her trial here is on the charge of forgery, and the ease goes into the United States court on a motion for a writ of habeas corpus, on the allegation that at the time the alleged forgeries were committed the accused was a resident of England. The trial was suspended and the hearing in the United States court is set for Feb. 12.
