

TRAINING WORKSHOP IN GENDER AND CROSSDRESSING

Professionals frequently encounter those with sexual and social concerns. Among these are the issues of gender and cross-dressing.

This workshop is designed to develop an awareness of individual attitudes and values related to these issues, an opportunity to relate with members of the paraculture, and to provide some representative models to facilitate effective counseling.

The term "paraculture" is used to describe all persons who are crossdressers and who have had some difficulty in transiting to an alternative lifestyle.

Recent understanding has shown the inadequacies of the literature and the need to share relevant experiences. We would hope that this Workshop will broaden one's understanding of these particular behaviors and provide a sound basis for effective client-counselor relationships.

The Outreach Foundation is a non profit educational organization engaged in sharing current knowledge and information about the paraculture with all interested persons.
